### Fisheries Adjustment Schemes Regulations 2009

#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the Fisheries Adjustment Schemes Regulations 2009.

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

#### 3. Terms used

**Abrolhos Islands Fishery** means the Fishery as defined in the Abrolhos Islands Notice clause 2;

Abrolhos Islands Notice means the Abrolhos Islands and Mid West Trawl Managed Fishery Voluntary Fisheries Adjustment Scheme Notice 2009;

*Abrolhos Islands Voluntary Scheme* means the voluntary fisheries adjustment scheme established by the Abrolhos Islands Notice clause 3;

*authorisation* means an authorisation that authorises fishing in the Abrolhos Islands Fishery;

**gear unit** has the meaning given in the *Abrolhos Islands and Mid West Trawl Limited Entry Fishery Notice 1993* clause 2.

#### 4. Fee under section 8 of Act imposed

- (1) For the purposes of the Abrolhos Islands Voluntary Scheme, the fee calculated in accordance with regulation 5 is imposed.
- (2) The fee is payable by the holder of an authorisation.

#### 5. Amount of fee fixed

- (1) If the number of gear units that apply to an authorisation is a whole number, the fee referred to in regulation 4 is the amount equal to \$5 011.34 multiplied by the number of gear units.
- (2) If the number of gear units that apply to an authorisation is not a whole number, the fee referred to in regulation 4 is the amount equal to the sum of
  - (a) \$5 011.34 multiplied by the number of gear units, disregarding any part of that number that is less than a whole number; and
  - (b) \$2 505.67.

#### 6. Payments to be made on 1 March for 10 years

- (1) The fee referred to in regulation 4 is payable annually on 1 March.
- (2) The first payment is due on 1 March 2010, and the final payment is due on 1 March 2019.
- (3) The fee is payable to the CEO at the head office of the Department.
