#### 1. Short title

This is the Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Capital 2010-11 Act 2010.

#### 2. Commencement

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act on the day after that day.

#### **3.** Issue and application of moneys

- (1) The sum of \$3 209 165 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply for the year from 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Recurrent 2010-11 Act 2010.*

#### 4. Appropriation for capital purposes

The sum of \$3 209 165 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
