Health (Offensive Trades Fees) Regulations 1976

1. Citation

These regulations are the Health (Offensive Trades Fees) Regulations 1976¹.

2. **Application**

These regulations have effect in every local government ² district within the State.

3. Prescribed fees

The fees set out in the Table to this regulation are payable on the registration of —

- (a) the offensive trades specified in Schedule 2 of the Act;
- any process or class of trade declared to be an offensive (b) trade under section 186 of the Act.
