No. 29 of 2011

An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2012.

[Assented to 11 July 2011]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

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s. 1

1. Short title

This is the Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Capital 2011-12 Act 2011.

2. Commencement

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act on the day after that day.

3. Issue and application of moneys

- The sum of \$3 781 131 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply for the year beginning on 1 July 2011 and ending on 30 June 2012.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Recurrent* 2011-12 Act 2011.

4. Appropriation for capital purposes

The sum of \$3 781 131 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
