Products Symbol Regulations 1980

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Products Symbol Regulations 1980*¹.

2. Interpretation

In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears —
“**the Act**” means the *Western Australian Products Symbol Act 1972*.

3. Certificate of appointment

- (1) Every person appointed to be an inspector under section 7 of the Act shall be furnished with a certificate evidencing his appointment, in the form of Form 1 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) The certificate referred to in subregulation (1) shall carry a photograph of the appointee and be signed by the appointee and the Minister.

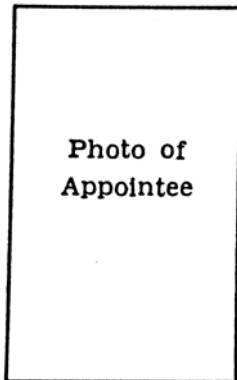
