Statutes (Repeals and Minor Amendments) Act 2011

No. 47 of 2011

An Act to amend the statute law by repealing various written laws and making minor amendments to various other written laws.

[Assented to 25 October 2011]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

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Part 1 — Preliminary matters

1. Short title

This is the *Statutes (Repeals and Minor Amendments) Act 2011.*

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows —

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent (*assent day*);
- (b) the rest of the Act on the day after assent day.
