What the reprint includes



Endnotes, Compilation table, and Table of provisions that have not come into operation

- 1. Details about the original regulations and legislation that has amended its text are shown in the Compilation table in endnote 1, at the back of the reprint. The table also shows any previous reprint.
- 2. Transitional, savings, modifying or other provisions identified in the Compilation table may be important. The table may refer to another endnote setting out the text of these provisions in full.
- 3. A table of provisions that have not come into operation, to be found in endnote 1a if it is needed, lists any provisions of the regulations being reprinted that have not come into operation and any amendments that have not come into operation. The full text is set out in another endnote that is referred to in the table.

Notes amongst text (italicised and within square brackets)

1. If the reprint includes a regulation that was inserted, or has been amended, since the regulations being reprinted were made, editorial notes at the foot of the regulation give some history of how the regulation came to be as it is. If the regulation replaced an earlier regulation, no history of the earlier regulation is given (the full history of the regulations is in the Compilation table).

Notes of this kind may also be at the foot of Schedules or headings.

- 2. The other kind of editorial note shows something has been -
 - removed (because it was repealed or deleted from the law); or
 - omitted under the *Reprints Act 1984* s. 7(4) (because, although still technically part of the text, it no longer has any effect).

The text of anything removed or omitted can be found in an earlier reprint (if there is one) or one of the written laws identified in the Compilation table.

Reprint numbering and date

- 1. The reprint number (in the footer of each page of the document) shows how many times the regulations have been reprinted. For example, numbering a reprint as "Reprint 3" would mean that the reprint was the 3rd reprint since the regulations were published. Reprint numbering was implemented as from 1 January 2003.
- 2. The information in the reprint is current on the date shown as the date as at which the regulations are reprinted. That date is not the date when the reprint was published by the State Law Publisher and it is probably not the date when the most recent amendment had effect.

Land Valuers Licensing Regulations 1979

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Land Valuers Licensing Regulations 1979*¹.

2. Terms used

In these regulations —

Act means the Land Valuers Licensing Act 1978;

Commissioner has the same meaning as it has in the *Fair Trading Act 2010*;

section means section of the Act.

- 4. Fees (Sch. 1)
 - (1) The fees set forth in Schedule 1 shall be payable in respect of the matters prescribed in that Schedule.

(2) If a licence is renewed in accordance with section 22 after the day on which the licence expired, a late fee equal to one quarter of the fee specified in item 2 of Schedule 1 for the renewal of the licence is payable in addition to that specified fee.

4A. Periods prescribed (Act s. 21(1) and 22(1))

- (1) For the purposes of section 21(1), the period prescribed is 3 years.
- (2) For the purposes of section 22(1), the further prescribed period is 3 years.

5. Notice of application for licence, advertisement of (Act s. 17(2))

- (1) Notice of an application for the grant of a licence to be advertised pursuant to section 17(2)
 - (a) shall be in an approved form; and
 - (b) shall be published by the applicant in a newspaper circulating in the State, within 14 days after the application is made.
- (2) An applicant for a licence shall lodge with the Commissioner the whole page of the newspaper, in which notice of his application was advertised in accordance with this regulation.

5A. Duplicate licence, issue of

If the Commissioner is satisfied that a licence has been lost, stolen or destroyed, the Commissioner may issue a duplicate licence on payment of the prescribed fee.

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6. Particulars in register prescribed (Act s. 29)

In the register of licensees kept by him pursuant to section 29 the Commissioner shall record in respect of each licensee the following particulars —

- (a) the name and address of the licensee; and
- (b) where the licensee carries on business as a land valuer under a business name — that business name and the address of any places of business; and
- (c) where the licensee is a director, partner or employee of a company or firm the name and address of the company or firm; and
- (d) where the licensee is employed in a department of the public service of the State or the Commonwealth or by a statutory authority, agency or instrumentality of the Crown in right of the State or the Commonwealth the name and address of the department, authority, agency or instrumentality; and
- (e) the licence number of the licence issued to the licensee and the date of its issue; and
- (f) particulars of any surrender, expiry, suspension or cancellation of the licence; and
- (g) particulars provided by the licensee pursuant to regulation 7.

7. Change of particulars, licensee to notify Commissioner

A licensee shall, within one month of any change of circumstance that is relative to the information kept in the register, notify the Commissioner in writing of that change. Penalty \$100.

(2) Where, upon the determination of any proceedings, the court or tribunal makes an order for costs in favour of a person other than the Commissioner the amount of those costs is a debt due to that person by the person against whom the order is made and may be sued for and recovered by the first-mentioned person in any court of competent jurisdiction.

10. Infringement notices, offences etc. prescribed (Sch. 2)

- (1) The offences specified in Schedule 2 are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in Schedule 2 is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of section 5(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (3) The Commissioner may, in writing, appoint persons or classes of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (4) The Commissioner is to issue to each authorised officer a certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.
