Energy Operators (Powers) Act 1979

Energy Operators (Powers) Regulations 2016

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Energy Operators (Powers) Regulations 2016.*

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Form of entry warrant (Act s. 46(7))

For section 46(7) of the Act, the form of a warrant authorising entry to premises is set out in Schedule 1 Form 1.

4. Form of inspector's certificate (Act s. 68(3))

For section 68(3) of the Act, the form of a certificate for an inspector is set out in Schedule 1 Form 2.

- 2. Specify the name of any person (other than a police officer) who is to enter the land, premises or thing together with an officer or servant of the energy operator. If no other person is to accompany an officer or servant of the energy operator, strike out the words "together with". Strike out the entire box if the warrant is to be executed only by one or more police officers.
- 3. Strike out the entire box if the warrant is to be executed without police assistance.
- 4. State the purpose for which the warrant is required.
