Dangerous Goods Safety Act 2004

Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2014

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2014.*

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day fixed under the *Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008* section 2(b).

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-explosives) Regulations 2007.*

4. Regulation 4 amended

In regulation 4 delete the definition of *driver licence* and insert:

driver licence means an Australian driver licence as defined in the Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008 section 3(1);

5. Regulation 215 amended

In regulation 215(4)(b) delete "Road Traffic Act 1974," and insert:

Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008 section 5,

6. Regulation 230 amended

- (1) Delete regulation 230(1)(c) and insert:
 - (c) in respect of which the person has been granted a vehicle licence under the *Road Traffic* (Vehicles) Act 2012 Part 2.
- (2) In regulation 230(3) delete "licence for the road vehicle granted under the *Road Traffic Act 1974* Part III." and insert:

vehicle licence granted under the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012* Part 2 for the road vehicle.
