## **Petroleum Products Pricing Amendment Regulations 2014**

Made by the Administrator in Executive Council.

### **1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Petroleum Products Pricing Amendment Regulations 2014*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

### **3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations 2000*.

Under that Act, some or all of the following action may be taken — your driver’s licence may be suspended; your vehicle licence may be suspended or cancelled; your details may be published on a website; your vehicle may be immobilised or have its number plates removed; and your property may be seized and sold.</p> <p><b>If you need more time</b> to pay the modified penalty, you should contact the authorised person at the address below.</p> <p>Paying the modified penalty will not be regarded as an admission for the purposes of any civil or criminal court case.</p> <p><b>If you want this matter to be dealt with by prosecution in court</b>, sign and date here:</p> <p>_____ / ____/20</p> <p>and post this notice to the authorised person at the address below within 28 days after the date of this notice.</p> <p>If you consider that you have good reason to have this notice withdrawn, you can write to the authorised person at the address below requesting that this notice be withdrawn and setting out the reasons why you consider that this notice should be withdrawn.
