## Jetties Amendment Regulations 2013

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

### 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Jetties Amendment Regulations 2013*.

### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

### 3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Jetties Regulations 1940*.

### 4. Schedule 1 clause 10 amended

In Schedule 1 clause 10(3) delete Table 10.2 and insert:

**6. Schedule 1 clause 20 amended**

In Schedule 1 clause 20(3) in Table 20.2 items 1 and 3 delete “charter vessel,”.
