Liquor Control Act 1988

Liquor Control Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2013

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Liquor Control Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2013.*

2. Commencement

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Liquor Control Regulations* 1989.

4. Regulation 18A amended

Delete regulation 18A(1) and insert:

(1) In this regulation —

Australian learner driver permit means —

- (a) a learner's permit as defined in the *Road Traffic Act 1974* section 5(1); or
- (b) a permit or other authorisation granted to a person under the law of another State or Territory authorising the person to drive a motor vehicle on a road for the purpose of learning to drive it.
- (2A) For the purposes of section 126(1)(b)(i)(III), the following are prescribed documents
 - (a) a proof of age card issued under regulation 18B;

(b) a current Australian learner driver permit with a photograph.
