Jetties Act 1926

Jetties Amendment Regulations 2012

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Jetties Amendment Regulations 2012*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the Jetties Regulations 1940.

4. Regulation 3 amended

- (1) In regulation 3(1) delete the definition of *pleasure vessel* or *recreational vessel*.
- (2) In regulation 3(1) insert in alphabetical order:

fishing vessel has the meaning given to that term in the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982* section 3(1);

recreational vessel has the meaning given to the term pleasure vessel in the Western Australian Marine Act 1982 section 98(1);

tourism vessel means a vessel used for commercial tourism purposes;
