# **Fair Trading (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006**

#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the Fair Trading (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006.

#### 2. Prescribed offences and modified penalties

- The offences specified in Schedule 1 are offences for which an (1) infringement notice may be issued under section 73 of the Act.
- (2) The modified penalty to be specified in an infringement notice issued for an offence is the modified penalty set out for that offence in Schedule 1.

#### **3. Forms**

The forms set out in Schedule 2 are prescribed in relation to the matters specified in those forms.
