Perth Parking Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the Perth Parking Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Perth Parking Management Regulations* 1999.

	(a) located on or adjacent to a park; and	
	(b) set aside during the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. solely for a vehicle being used by a person or persons who, throughout the period the vehicle is parked in the bay, engages or	11
	engage in a recreational activity in the park	nil
