Health (Notifications by Midwives) Amendment Regulations 2017

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Health (Notifications by Midwives) Amendment Regulations 2017.*

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on 1 July 2017.

3. Regulations amended
