Gaming and Wagering Commission Amendment Regulations 2007

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Gaming and Wagering Commission Amendment Regulations 2007.*

2. Commencement

- (b) the rest of the regulations on 1 January 2008.
