## **Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2007**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2007*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows:

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day that the *Road Traffic Amendment (Drugs) Act 2007* Part 2 comes into operation.

**3. The regulations amended**

The amendment in these regulations is to the *Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1975*.

**4. Schedule 9 amended**

Schedule 9 is amended under the Authority heading "*Road Traffic Act 1974*" by inserting the following items in the appropriate numerical sequence —
