Government Employees' Housing Regulations 1965

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Government Employees'* Housing Regulations 1965¹.

2. Interpretation

In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears — *metropolitan region* has the same meaning as is from time to time ascribed to it by the *Town Planning and Development Act 1928*:

the Act means the Government Employees' Housing Act 1964.

5. Tenancy agreement

- (2) Every person to whom a house is let pursuant to the Act shall if required by the Authority enter into a tenancy agreement with

the Authority in such form as the Authority may from time to time determine.

6. Form of warrant

For the purposes of section 28(2) of the Act, a warrant issued by a court of summary jurisdiction upon application made by the Authority or its agent under that subsection, shall be in the following form —
