Marine Navigational Aids Act 1973

**Marine Navigational Aids Amendment
Regulations 2009**

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in
Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Marine Navigational Aids Amendment Regulations 2009*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on 1 July 2009.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Marine Navigational Aids Regulations 1985*.

4. Regulation 3 amended

In regulation 3(1) delete “the Schedule” and insert:

Schedule 1 — Fees — Fishing Boats

The fees in the Table are payable in respect of the provision of marine navigational aids outside any port under the control of a port authority and the approaches to that port.

| More than 20 m but not more than 30 m | 342.50 |
| More than 30 m but not more than 50 m | 522.60 |
| More than 50 m | 816.70 |
