Marine Navigational Aids Amendment Regulations 2009

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the Marine Navigational Aids Amendment Regulations 2009.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on 1 July 2009.

3. Regulations amended

The fees in the Table are payable in respect of the provision of marine navigational aids outside any port under the control of a port authority and the approaches to that port.
