Port Authorities Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2007

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Port Authorities Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2007*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows:

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of these regulations — on the later of —
 - (i) the day after that day; or
 - (ii) 1 July 2007.

3. The regulations amended
