PROCLAMATION SUMMONING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

By this proclamation, I, the Governor, acting under the Constitution Act 1889 section 3—

- (a) fix Parliament House in the City of Perth as the place for holding the first session of the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council in the 38th Parliament; and
- (b) fix Thursday 6 November 2008 at 11.00 a.m. as the time for holding the first sitting of the first session of the Legislative Assembly in the 38th Parliament; and
- (c) fix Thursday 6 November 2008 at 2.45 p.m. as the time for holding the first sitting of the first session of the Legislative Council in the 38th Parliament.
