Electricity (Supply Standards and System Safety) Amendment Regulations 2005

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Electricity (Supply Standards and System Safety) Amendment Regulations 2005.*

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 January 2006.

3. The regulations amended

4. Regulation 3 amended

Regulation 3(1) is amended by deleting the definition of "low voltage".

5. Part 2 repealed

Part 2 is repealed.

6. Regulation 35 amended

- (1) Regulation 35(1) is repealed and the following subregulation is inserted instead
 - A network operator must notify the Director of any incident or event that is caused, or significantly contributed to, by electricity and that results in —
 - (a) serious injury; or
 - (b) serious damage.
- (2) Regulation 35(4) is repealed.

7. Regulation 41 amended

Regulation 41 is amended as follows:

- (a) in paragraph (k) by deleting "; or" and inserting a full stop instead;
- (b) by deleting paragraph (l).

8. Schedules 1, 4 and 5 repealed

Schedules 1, 4 and 5 are repealed.
