## **Door to Door Trading Amendment Regulations 2004**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Door to Door Trading Amendment Regulations 2004*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

**3. The regulations amended**

The amendment in these regulations is to the *Door to Door Trading Regulations 1987\**.

**4. Regulation 2A inserted**

After regulation 2 the following regulation is inserted —

“

**2A. Contracts to which the Act does not apply**

(1) The Act does not apply to a gas supply contract.

(2) In this regulation —

“**small use customer**” has the meaning given to that term in section 3 of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*;

**“gas supply contract”** means an arrangement between a retail supplier and a small use customer for the supply of gas to the customer;

**“retail supplier”** means a person who holds a trading licence which authorises the person to sell gas transported through a distribution system to small use customers;

**“trading licence”** has the meaning given to that term in section 3 of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*.
