Door to Door Trading Act 1987

Door to Door Trading Amendment Regulations 2004

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Door to Door Trading Amendment Regulations 2004*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

3. The regulations amended

The amendment in these regulations is to the *Door to Door Trading Regulations 1987**.

4. Regulation 2A inserted

After regulation 2 the following regulation is inserted —

2A. Contracts to which the Act does not apply

- (1) The Act does not apply to a gas supply contract.
- (2) In this regulation —

"small use customer" has the meaning given to that term in section 3 of the *Energy Coordination*Act 1994;

- "gas supply contract" means an arrangement between a retail supplier and a small use customer for the supply of gas to the customer;
- "retail supplier" means a person who holds a trading licence which authorises the person to sell gas transported through a distribution system to small use customers;
- "trading licence" has the meaning given to that term in section 3 of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*.
