Liquor Licensing Amendment Regulations 2004

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing Amendment Regulations 2004*.

2. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Liquor Licensing Regulations 1989**.

3. Regulation 3 amended

Regulation 3(1) is amended by deleting the definition of "wine tax" and inserting instead —

"

"WET" has the meaning given to "wine tax" in section 33-1 of the Commonwealth *A New Tax System (Wine Equalisation Tax) Act 1999.*

4. Regulation 8 amended

- Regulation 8(1)(e) is amended by deleting "territorial waters of the State" and inserting instead —
 - WA territorial seas ".
- (2) After regulation 8(1) the following subregulation is inserted
 - (1a) In subregulation (1)(e)
 - **"WA territorial seas"** means 12 nautical miles of sea off the coast of the State, measured from baselines determined in accordance with Part II Section 2 of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea done at Montego Bay on 10 December 1982.
