5A. Exercise of Court's powers in Part 3 of the Act

4. Rule 8 amended

Rule 8(1) is amended by deleting "are served with a claim against you," and inserting instead —

" make a claim, ".

5. Rule 13 amended

6. Rule 22A inserted

After rule 22 the following rule is inserted into Part 4 —

22A. Registrar may order costs after giving judgment
