## **Business Names Amendment Regulations 2006**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

### 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Business Names Amendment Regulations 2006*.

## 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the later of ---

- (a) the day on which they are published in the *Gazette*; and
- (b) the day on which the *Criminal Procedure Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2006* come into operation.

#### 3. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Business Names Regulations 1962*\*.

#### Forms

#### 11. Infringement notices

(1) The offences specified in the Fourth Schedule are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.

".

- (2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in the Fourth Schedule is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of section 5(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (3) The Commissioner may, in writing, appoint persons or classes of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (4) The Commissioner is to issue to each authorised officer a certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.

## 6. First Schedule repealed

The First Schedule is repealed.
