Painters' Registration Act 1961 Criminal Procedure Act 2004

Painters' Registration (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Painters' Registration (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2006.*

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the later of -

- (a) the day on which they are published in the Gazette; and
- (b) the day on which the *Criminal Procedure Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2006* come into operation.

3. Prescribed offences and modified penalties

- The offences specified in Schedule 1 are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004* Part 2.
- (2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in Schedule 1 is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004* section 5(3).

4. Authorised officers and approved officers

- (1) The Board may, in writing, appoint persons or classes of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004* Part 2.
- (2) The Board is to issue to each authorised officer a certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.

5. Forms

The forms set out in Schedule 2 are prescribed in relation to the matters specified in those forms.
