# **Street Collections Amendment Regulations 2006**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Street Collections Amendment Regulations 2006*.

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the later of —

- (a) the day on which they are published in the Gazette; and
- (b) the day on which the Criminal Procedure Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2006 come into operation.

### 3. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Street Collections Regulations 1999\**.

#### 4. Regulation 2 amended

Regulation 2 is amended by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical position —

"Commissioner" has the same meaning as it has in the Consumer Affairs Act 1971;

Regulation 14 is repealed and the following regulations are inserted instead —

#### 14. Infringement notices

- (1) The offences specified in Schedule 2 are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in Schedule 2 is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of section 5(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (3) The Commissioner may, in writing, appoint persons or classes of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act* 2004.
- (4) The Commissioner is to issue to each authorised officer a certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.

#### 15. Forms

The forms set out in Schedule 3 are prescribed in relation to the matters specified in those forms.
