The Companies Amendment Regulations 2006

43. Infringement notices

- The offences specified in Schedule III are offences for which an infringement notice may be issued under Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (2) The modified penalty specified opposite an offence in Schedule III is the modified penalty for that offence for the purposes of section 5(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (3) The Registrar may, in writing, appoint persons or classes of persons to be authorised officers or approved officers for the purposes of Part 2 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2004*.
- (4) The Registrar is to issue to each authorised officer a certificate, badge or identity card identifying the officer as a person authorised to issue infringement notices.
