Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Amendment Regulations 2005

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Amendment Regulations 2005.*

2. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Regulations 2004**.

3. Regulation 5 amended

Regulation 5(1) is amended in the Table to the subregulation as follows:

(a) by deleting item 2 and inserting the following item instead —

2 Clearing resulting from accidents or to reduce danger

Clearing —

(a) for the purposes of preventing imminent danger to human life or health or irreversible damage to a significant portion of the environment; or

The owner of the land on which the clearing is to take place.

(b) as a result of an accident caused otherwise than by the negligence of the person clearing or the person who authorised the clearing.

A person responsible for the safety or welfare of the persons who are likely to be in danger or for the portion of the environment.

(b) in item 23, paragraph (b) of the description of clearing, by deleting "6 months" and inserting instead —" 18 months".
