Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Act 1994

Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Amendment Regulations 2000

Made by the Administrator in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Amendment Regulations 2000.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which the *Acts Amendment (Fines Enforcement) Act 2000* comes into operation.

3. Regulation 6C inserted

After regulation 6B of the Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Regulations 1994* the following regulation is inserted —

6C. Reduction of liability to pay fine where WDO taken to be cancelled (s. 57B(7) Sentencing Act 1995)

- This regulation applies if a WDO has been wholly or partially completed at the time it is to be taken to be cancelled under section 57B(5) of the Sentencing Act 1995.
- (2) If the WDO has been wholly completed, the offender's liability to pay the fine is discharged.
- (3) If the WDO has been partially completed, the fine payable by the offender is to be reduced by \$150 for every 6 hours worked.
