### Road Traffic Act 1974

# Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2000

Made by the Administrator in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2000.

### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2000.
