# Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2001

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Licensing) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2001.* 

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 5 February 2001.

## 3. Regulations 3D and 3E inserted

After regulation 3C of the *Road Traffic (Licensing)*Regulations 1975\* the following regulations are inserted into Part II —

"

### 3D. Minimum age of applicant for issue of a licence

- (1) Except as provided in subregulation (2), the minimum age at which an individual may apply for the issue of a vehicle licence is 16 years.
- (2) The minimum age at which an individual may apply for the issue of a vehicle licence for a heavy vehicle is 18 years.

# **3E.** Proof of age and identity of applicant for issue of a licence

An application for the issue of a vehicle licence is to be accompanied by such proof of the applicant's age and identity as the Director General may require.
