MARINE AND HARBOURS ACT 1981 PROCLAMATION

I, the Governor, acting under the $Marine\ and\ Harbours\ Act\ 1981$ section 9 and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council—

- (a) cancel the proclamation made under the *Marine and Harbours Act 1981* section 9, dated 9 July 2002 and published in the *Gazette* on 12 July 2002 at page 3374; and
- (b) revest in the Crown the portion of land and harbour bed described in the Schedule to that proclamation other than the land and seabed set out in Schedule 1 to this proclamation; and
- (c) vest in The Minister for Transport, constituted under the *Marine and Harbours Act 1981* section 8(1), the land and seabed set out in Schedule 1 to this proclamation,

with effect on and from the day after the day on which this proclamation is published in the $\it Gazette$.


Schedule 1—Casuarina Boat Harbour
