Criminal Investigation (Identifying People) Act 2002

**Criminal Investigation (Identifying People)  
Amendment Regulations 2017**

Made by the deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Criminal Investigation (Identifying People) Amendment Regulations 2017*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Criminal Investigation (Identifying People) Regulations 2002*.

**4. Regulation 5A replaced**

Delete regulation 5A and insert:

**5A. Disclosure of identifying information (s. 73(1)(n))**

For section 73(1)(n) of the Act, the following purposes are prescribed —

- (a) the Australian Crime Commission's national policing information functions under the *Australian Crime Commission Act 2002* (Commonwealth);
- (b) a review, special inquiry or investigation under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* Part 3A Division 3.
