PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA John Sanderson, Governor

I, the Governor, acting under item 3 of the Second Schedule to the Stamp Act 1921 and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, declare as follows:

- 1. This proclamation commences on the day on which it is published in the Government Gazette.
- 2. The proclamation made under item 3 of the Second Schedule to the Stamp Act 1921 and published in the Government Gazette of 24 April 1980 is revoked.
- 3. The duty payable under item 3(1)(a) or (b) of the Second Schedule to the Stamp Act 1921 is 2/12 of a cent for every dollar and part of a dollar of the purchase price referred to in the respective subitem.
- 4. Despite clause 3, the duty payable in respect of the amount of the purchase money of any one animal, or any one carcass, whether sold singly or as part of a lot, must not exceed the sum of 20 cents.
