1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 1997.

Regulation 4 amended

- 2. Regulation 4 (6) of the Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1975* is repealed and the following subregulation is substituted
 - (6) An applicant for a licence to drive a Class T vehicle shall be the holder of a driver's licence $\,$
 - (a) that is appropriate to the class, other than Class T, to which the vehicle being, or to be, operated as a taxi belongs; and
 - (b) that is not issued on probation.
