Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Workers' Compensation (Compensation Magistrate's Court) Amendment Rules 1997.

Rule 4 amended

- 2. Rule 4 of the *Workers' Compensation (Compensation Magistrate's Court) Rules 1994** is amended by repealing subrule (5) and substituting the following subrule
 - (5) A party to the appeal is to lodge with the court and serve on each other party to the appeal $\boldsymbol{-}$
 - (a) in the case of the party making the appeal, at least 7 days before the day when the hearing of the appeal is to commence; and
 - (b) in the case of a party responding to the appeal, at least 4 days before the day when the hearing of the appeal is to commence,

notice of any submission that is to be made and a list of cases or other authorities to which reference is to be made.
