STATE TRADING CONCERNS ACT 1916

STATE TRADING CONCERNS (AUTHORIZATION) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1997

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the State Trading Concerns (Authorization) Amendment Regulations 1997.

Regulation 3 added

2. After regulation 2 of the State Trading Concerns (Authorization) Regulations 1997* the following regulation is added —

Prescribed financial entity and prescribed activity — Chemistry Centre (WA)

- 3. (1) The Chemistry Centre (WA) is a prescribed financial entity for the purposes of section 4A (2) (a) of the Act.
- (2) The provision by the Chemistry Centre (WA) of scientific support (primarily chemistry based) to industry and to the public is a prescribed activity for the purposes of section 4A (2) (b) of the Act.
 - (3) In subregulation (2) —

"scientific support" includes —

- (a) providing analytical information;
- (b) providing expert advice and expert evidence;
- (c) solving problems; and
- (d) carrying out investigative and applied research projects.
