EXPLOSIVES AND DANGEROUS GOODS ACT 1961
EXPLOSIVES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1996

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Explosives Amendment Regulations 1996*.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1996.

Principal regulations

3. In these regulations the *Explosives Regulations 1963** are referred to as the principal regulations.
