PLANT DISEASES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 9) 1996

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations (No. 9) 1996.

Schedule 1 amended

- 2. Schedule 1 to the Plant Diseases Regulations 1989* is amended
 - (a) in Part A by deleting the item relating to Lupin and substituting the following item —

- (b) in Part B
 - (i) in item 1 by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical position the following —

Lupin: Plants — Anthracnose (Colletotrichum gloeosporioides) and Fusarium Wilt (Fusarium oxysporum f. lupini).

and

(ii) by deleting item 51 and substituting the following item —

51. Lupin seed — Anthracnose and Fusarium Wilt

Entry of Lupin seed is permitted if the seed is -

- (a) approved for entry;
- (b) to be grown in post-entry quarantine;
- (c) to be screened for disease; and
- (d) to be found free from lupin attacking strains of the fungus Anthracnose (Colletotrichum gloeosporioides) and Fusarium Wilt (Fusarium oxysporum f. lupini) before the release of progeny.
