RADIATION SAFETY ACT 1975

RADIATION SAFETY (GENERAL) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1996

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Radiation Safety (General) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1996.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1996.

Principal regulations

3. In these regulations the Radiation Safety (General) Regulations 1983* are referred to as the principal regulations.
