POISONS ACT 1964
POISONS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 4) 1995

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 1995*.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1995.

Principal regulations

3. In these regulations the *Poisons Regulations 1965** are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 12 amended

4. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is amended —
- (a) in subregulation (1) by deleting “, together with the appropriate fee prescribed in Appendix G”; and
 - (b) by inserting after subregulation (2) the following subregulation —

(3) The Commissioner of Health shall issue a licence or permit under these regulations to a successful applicant only after the appropriate fee, prescribed in Appendix G, is paid.

”
