**RADIATION SAFETY ACT 1975
RADIATION SAFETY (GENERAL) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS
(No. 2) 1995**

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Radiation Safety (General) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1995*.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1995.

Principal regulations

3. In these regulations the *Radiation Safety (General) Regulations 1983** are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 58 amended
