#### RADIATION SAFETY ACT 1975 RADIATION SAFETY (GENERAL) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1995

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Radiation Safety (General) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1995.

### Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1995.

### Principal regulations
