STOCK DISEASES (REGULATIONS) ACT 1968

ENZOOTIC DISEASES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1996

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Enzootic Diseases Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1996*.

Fourth Schedule amended

2. (1) The Fourth Schedule to the *Enzootic Diseases Regulations 1970** is amended by inserting after item 2 the following items —

“

2A. Vaccination of stock brought into the State (regulation 31) —

For single animal or first animal in a consignment	15.00
For each additional animal	2.00

PLUS an additional service charge for vaccinations carried out more than 50 km from an inspection point or other departmental office* 31.00

[*This charge does not apply if an additional service charge is paid in relation to the same animal(s) for an inspection carried out at the same time and place.]

2B. Collection of samples from stock brought into the State (regulation 31) —

For single animal or first animal in a consignment	15.00
For each additional animal	1.10

PLUS an additional service charge for samples taken more than 50 km from an inspection point or other departmental office* 31.00

[*This charge does not apply if an additional service charge is paid in relation to the same animal(s) for an inspection carried out at the same time and place.]

 same animal(s) for an inspection carried out
 at the same time and place.]

(3) Items 4 and 5 of the Fourth Schedule are deleted.
