POISONS AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (NO. 3) 1994

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 1994*.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into operation on 1 August 1994.
